

Scholarship Criteria Sheet

- 1. Student is unable to travel without financial assistance
- 2. Student's family is unable to fund the entire tour fee but will be able to raise a portion of the needed funds
- 3. Student is a hard worker, earns good grades, takes challenging course work and does not have behavioral issues
- 4. Student is interested in experiencing other cultures, history, art, and languages and would greatly benefit from such an experience.
- 5. Student would be a great representative of his/her school, city and the United States of America
- 6. Student is open minded, adventurous, curious, reflective and empathetic
- 7. Student gets along well with others and respects authority
- 8. Student reacts positively and is adaptive and flexible when faced with new experiences or situations
- 9. Student is interested in the world at large and is culturally sensitive to others that may be different from themselves.
- 10. Teachers/staff/administration at school agree that the student will need financial assistance and that the student would make a good candidate for this program
- **Exceptions may be made regarding #2 in special circumstances and will be decided on a case by case basis.
- **Applicants may be required to participate in an interview process if requested by the organization
